President's Remarks:

This public hearing was advertised in the Pike County Dispatch on June 20, 2024. The purpose of this hearing is to potentially enact an Ordinance amending Chapter 118 of the Borough Code, regulating Vehicles and Traffic. If enacted, the Ordinance will amend §118-27 to establish a two-hour time limit on both sides of First Street from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. from Pennsylvania Ave to Avenue K.

Allyson Gillinder of Ave N: Inquired as to the reason driving this and how will this be enforced.
