President's Remarks: The purpose of this workshop is to discuss the 2025 Budget. This workshop was advertised in the Pike County Dispatch on December 21, 2023.

Accounting services and cost were discussed. Lisa Salvato will be meeting with Myer & Myer later this week. PCLP bills that are split with the DPW and Fire Department were discussed and will be investigated further. Earmarking \$9,000 of the tree maintenance for brush. Suggested setting up a large-scale paving project schedule.

Mr. Madsen noted discussed moving the garbage to the Municipal Authority. The General Government mil will drop to 30, a slight tax reprieve. He noted some of the general government increases we are facing in 2025. The comprehensive plan, the police contract, central sewage engineering fees, vehicle expenditures. Expenses keep increasing as our revenue remains the same. Stated that the borough is not frivolously spending money.
